Chair Report: Wanda C.

Highlights of 2022 WSBC (Formal Report will be sent out for the June meeting.)

- 1. Please refer to the OA WSBC 2022 Report by Chris B. for conference highlights.
- 2. Look at the OA WSBC Workshop handouts that were sent out in the SNI Eblast.
- 3. Twenty-one (21) countries were represented at the WSBC!
- 4. Even though the conference was virtual, delegates were charged a registration fee of \$175. to cover the costs.
- 5. WSO was still obligated to pay \$131,000 to the hotel, even though the conference was not in person.
- 6. One of the Proposals concerned the Protection Payment Program (PPP). OA received \$137,000 from the government during the pandemic to help cover costs (rent and staff salaries). This money was "gifted" and does not need to be paid back. (Nor does the government want it back.) The Conference Proposal on this issue was debated. A faction thought that the money should be paid back, because our Seventh Tradition states that OA should be self-supporting. After discussion, the WSBC decided that the money would not be paid back.
- 7. Although OA was concerned about funds, because of the pandemic, OA broke the million-dollar donation mark and is doing quite well.
- 8. *The Twelve Traditions Workbook of Overeaters Anonymous* was given Conference Seal of Approval.
- 9. The Responsibility Pledge will be added to all new materials.
- 10. A free download of the Pdf pamphlet *Where Do I Start*? was approved and will be available soon.
- 11. The Screen Sharing Proposal was defeated.
- 12. Interpreters will now be allowed to speak for people who for some reason are unable to speak, (i.e.-strep throat, technical difficulties on Zoom).
- 13. Region 5 Trustee Barb. K. was re-elected to the Board of Trustees (BOT).
- 14. At this point, WSBC is not set up to host a hybrid conference. However, things are moving in that direction and OA needs to catch up. The plan is for next year's WSBC to be in-person.

SNI Handbook

- SNI Reps can choose to print off a paper copy of the Handbook (an option) or use the Handbook in its electronic format on their computer.
