<u>Chair Report</u>: (Wanda C.) – Wanda C. reported on her work with the Region 5 PIPO Committee. The committee is working on two initiatives. 1) "Elevator Pitch" – Developing a 30-60 second "pitch" that tells someone else about your OA experience. This might be formatted in two different ways-one for someone you know, the other for a stranger. 2) "Poster Party" – SNI or any meeting group would select OA posters that they like and print them off (at SNI's expense). The group would meet, then disperse to put up the posters, meeting at the end of an agreed-upon time for reflection. -Wanda C. will present her R5 Summer Session and Young Peoples' Reports at a later date.

<u>Vice Chair Report:</u> (Carolyn S.) – Carolyn S. has been "talking up" the SNI website to various meeting groups encouraging members to visit the site. As Carolyn S. stated, "It's easy, convenient and anonymous." Reported that she will be chairing the upcoming Elections that will be held in October.

Recording Secretary Report: (Laural R.) – The SNI website has been added to the Meeting List as directed. -There have been 1,900 hits on the website. -Only one SNI member submitted their personal recovery story. Other SNI members are encouraged to write a recovery story for the website. – <u>Literature</u>: Because many meetings are remaining zoom only, they have extra literature and have requested SNI's guidance on what to do. Laural R. will contact Region 5's Barb K. for more specific direction, especially regarding any out-of-date literature. SNI is open to having a meeting group bring their extra literature to one of our Recovery Events and sell it at a reduced rate or for a donation.

<u>Acting Corresponding Secretary Report</u>: (Maureen R.) -The Wednesday St. Martha School meeting is now Zoom only. This change is reflected on the current Meeting List information. – Maureen R. explained her responsibilities as "keeper" of the Sponsorship List and suggested that anyone needing a sponsor can be referred to her.

Region 5 2022 Convention and Business

<u>Hospitality Report</u> (Darlette P.) Darlette P. reported that everyone is ready and looking forward to the Convention on September 16-18, 2022. On Thursday, 9/15 at 6 pm there will be a "Dry Run" for the Saturday and Sunday Convention days.

SNI Friday Night Meeting Report (Deanna B.) -Deanna and her committee are ready to go. Deanna explained that members involved in this meeting do NOT need to participate in the "Dry Run" of the Convention. Everyone involved in the meeting has been notified of their responsibilities.

SNI Elections (Carolyn S.) – As Vice Chair Carolyn S. is responsible for the October Elections. She serves as the chair of the Nominating Committee, which was formed. Carolyn S., Christine G., Maureen R., and June L. will serve on the committee. Carolyn S. is also responsible for conducting the elections. She will contact John C. to ask if he can serve as SNI's Election Judge (person in charge of counting the votes). If not, Carolyn S. will contact Region 5's Barb K. regarding setting up an on-line poll for the vote for those people on Zoom. Members present in-person will vote by secret ballot. Elections will be the first item on the SNI October Agenda.

Intergroup Renewal Goals

<u>Strengthening SNI by Visiting Meeting Groups (Maureen R.)</u> – No formal report. There are still some meeting groups without SNI representation. SNI members were encouraged to continue to reach out to other meeting groups.

TSW and Feedback about Body Image Event (Maureen R) -TSW Report was sent in the SNI Eblast. Maureen R. reviewed the report, specifically the evaluations, which were very positive. Each person attending the SNI Meeting had the opportunity to reflect on the event from their personal perspective. Regarding improvements, evaluations indicated that people would like more time for sharing and interactions. -Another TSW Recovery Event was discussed, and a TSW committee was formed. Maureen R., Carol G., and Carolyn S. will investigate the specifics of our next event. -SNI is also able to assist individual meeting groups who want to organize a recovery event by providing "guidelines" for organizing an event and financial support. Carolyn S. mentioned that the Monday St. Simon's Meeting

has focused on the Big Book during the pandemic and might be interested in organizing a recovery event in the future. SNI would support this recovery event.

<u>Temporary Sponsors: Newcomers' First Twelve Days</u> (Laural R.) – The purpose of the *First Twelve Days* in OA is to help newcomers learn about the Twelve Step recovery program through a twelve-session introduction to OA. Laural R. will send out the materials to all SNI members in her "What to Bring Back to Your Meeting Groups" Eblast. Susan M. will speak more on this topic at our October Meeting. Wanda C. attended a "How to be a Temporary Sponsor" workshop. There is another workshop coming up in October. A flyer will be forwarded to all members. We are encouraged to attend.

<u>Committees/Volunteer Groups, PIPO, Bylaws</u> -Carol G. stressed the importance of PIPO in "carrying the message to other compulsive eaters who are still suffering." She is willing to work on this, but not alone. More specifics will be discussed at our October meeting.
