

- Considerations regarding a **possibility of SNI merging with one or more other intergroup(s)**:
 - **If we decide to dissolve SNI**, meetings could affiliate with Turning Point Intergroup (TPI). Check out their website: OACHicagoTPI.org.
 - If you are available to visit one or more of TPI meetings, please do so to see if affiliating with TPI would be a good fit.
 - Please consider what you appreciate about SNI, as well as what you would like your intergroup to provide.
 - TPI generally meets the 3rd Sunday of the month from 10:30 am to 11:45 am on Zoom.
 - The next two TPI meetings will be held 9/20 and 10/18.
 - **If we choose to continue as SNI**, we will need volunteers to run for board positions, as well as for Region 5 representative and World Service delegate.
 - It would be helpful to have more group representatives and visitors at our meeting, too. The more people involved, the less any one person needs to do. Our elections are scheduled to be held October 3rd.
 - Volunteers could take turns serving as acting secretary, for instance, so that one person isn't taking on too much service.
 - **The meeting to discuss possible mergers** with all 4 Chicagoland intergroups is being **reconsidered**. Since we are now discussing the possibility of SNI merging with TPI and CHI-WIF merging with CSSI, it may make more sense to have meetings with just two intergroups at a time. I will send out information on upcoming meetings when I have it.
